Background

VIN has been organizing work camps in Jitpur community for the development of different field. On the month of July, VIN received 19 work camp volunteers for two different programs. Programs were **'School health talk on hygiene and sanitation, 2013'** and **'Jitpurphedi Gardening/Painting'**. Under these programs many activities were conducted in Jitpurphedi community. The programs aimed to bring development in schools of the community. This report explains the activities of 'Jitpurphedi gardening/ Painting'. Painting'.

The work camp on Painting, coloring, ground maintenance and afforestation in Mahadevsthan Primary School, Dandagaun was conducted from 4th July to 12th July, 2013. the importance of this work camp in this school is very high compare to other school. The land around the school is public/private and not much is owned by school. It is barren and due to the lack of the trees the landslides occur during the rainy season. This project aims to plant flowers and trees around school to make environment friendly area. There were seven international volunteers from different countries and a local volunteer was placed for that work to facilitate them.

Objectives

The overall objective of this work camp is to promote volunteerism in the community and to assist the school in maintaining clean and calm environment.

The specific objectives of this work camp are as follows:

- To paint the wall and fence of school compound.
- To make the ground plain.
- To make garden around school area.
- To paint the school wall.
- To promote friendship, understanding and

solidarity among local people and international workcamp volunteers.

• To develop cultural immersion

Major Activities

- Paint the school fence and school gate
- Maintenance of play ground
- Afforestation in the school area









Methodology

The group volunteers received orientation at VIN office for their work schedules, their specific jobs; their roles and responsibilities. According to their schedule, they were first taken for an observation in the community. These volunteers divided their roles themselves for painting the fence and maintaining ground. Forestation was done in the school area in order to avoid the landslides and other disaster in future. Volunteers prepared the ground for the plantation.

The volunteers first coloured the fence and the gates. They showed so much of interest to color the fence and the gate. They filled up the holes in play ground, managed stones and bricks of the ground made it flat and smooth for the kids to play.



Achievement

- Painted the fences and gates of Mahadevsthan and Dadagau school
- The play ground of the school is made smooth and flat
- The school area has been made healthy through plantation

Challenges

- The season being summer, it was very hot due to which many volunteers were sun burn
- Due to the rainy season, the paint on the fence was washed away so they had to paint thrice.
- The distance between the working area and host family was long and slippery
- It was sometimes, difficult to manage time due to rain
- Lack of tools to maintain ground
- One of the volunteers was sick on the whole day of the work camp
